RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF ACTION IN MUSKOGEE

PRIORITIES

- The Muskogee City-County Port Authority takes responsibility that the completed Action In Muskogee (AIM) Plan will be implemented.
- The Business and Economic Development Department of the Muskogee City-County Port Authority along with the AIM Steering committee will monitor, evaluate and manage the committees and priorities of AIM.
- The Department and Steering Committee will also oversee the Priority Champions to insure the goals and objectives are being completed.
- The Department will communicate the progress of AIM activities to the Steering Committee, the participants, area organizations and general public on a periodic basis.
- The Department and AIM Steering Committee will work in partnership with area organizations to achieve the objectives of AIM.
- This group will also organize future collaborations with necessary partners in order to meet financial requirements of AIM priorities.
